The California Federation of Teachers Recommends Anamarie Avila Farias for the State Assembly District 15 Seat

On Saturday, November 4th, Anamarie Avila Farias, Contra Costa County Board of Education Trustee, received the endorsement of the California Federation of Teachers (CFT) for State Assembly, District 15. Through its local unions, CFT represents more than 120,000 education workers at every level of public and private education from Head Start through university. Anamarie is running to represent California State Assembly District 15, a seat being vacated by Assemblymember Tim Grayson. The district encompasses Martinez, Pittsburg, Antioch, portions of Brentwood and Pleasant Hill and unincorporated areas of Contra Costa County.
